We are working on a summer white wine called **Queen's Lace**, a blend of Chardonnay and Cayuga. This lighter summer white is full of wonderful fruit flavors, slightly sweeter (about 2% RS) and received excellent reviews from our panel of tasters. Thank you to all who visited us this past weekend and was brave to taste from the lab beakers. I love to watch your eyes light up when you see the "beaker" on the tasting bar.

Since we don't have room to bring you up to the wine cellar for barrel tastings just yet, Mike brought wine down to the tasting room in lab beakers. We gave samples of our barrel reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir and Late Harvest Chardonnay, receiving excellent reviews on all wines samples. We plan to bottle these varietals in the very near future.

Stop by this weekend for Jester's Juice and you never know when Mike might bring down a lab beaker filled with another trial blend. We want you, our customers, help us with our blends this year.
